6. **PREVIOUS PLANNING APPLICATIONS APPROVED/REJECTED:**

6.1 – *Bradford House – Erection of a potato store farm building – **Approved.***

6.2 - *Land adjoining the Dormers, Mustow Green – Variation of Conditions 2 and 6 of planning application no. WF 528/01 to enable a substitution of plans and boundary treatment – **Approved.***

6.3 – *1 Sion Court, Hillpool – Replacement of existing conservatory with garden room - **Approved.***

7. **PLANNING APPLICATIONS FOR CONSIDERATION**

7.1 **08/0092/FULL – Drayton Mill:** Conversion of Mill to 2 dwellings.

The Parish Council did not feel that a residential development was a suitable option for this building on this site. Further effort should be made to find a commercial or industrial use for the building.

7.2 **08/0141/FULL – Apperley House, Harvington:** Change of use from dog breeding to the boarding of cats and dogs – replacement of existing building with purpose built cat and dog pens. **No objections.**

7.3 **08/0148/FULL – Friars Farm, Worcester Road, Harvington:** Change of use from agricultural workshop to office/studio use. The majority decision was to object to the proposal as being unsuitable development for this building.

7.4 **08/0169/FULL – Wheel Cottage, Hillpool:** Erection of a dining room and utility room. The majority had no objection to this proposal.
